Guy P. “Mac” McSweeney entered Staunton Military Academy (SMA) in the fall of 1944 from Palmetto, FL, and was in the band as a junior and senior (sergeant). He ran track as a junior and senior (co-captain) and was a member of the Flying Club prior to graduating in 1946.

Following graduation from SMA, “Mac” attended the Citadel where he earned a Business Degree in 1950.

Guy entered the U.S. Air Force 1950 immediately after graduating from the Citadel and flew over 100 missions in F-80's over Korea. He left the military service in 1956 and got his introduction into telecommunications as a Sales Representative with A.B. Andrews.

Commencing in 1962, he served as President of Resco, Inc., a Radio Engineering and Telecommunications company.

In 1993, Ram Technologies, Inc. reached a milestone in their business and needed the expert advice of outside business executives, thus a Board of Directors was created. In 1995, Guy P. McSweeney was named to the Board of Directors and later became the Chief Executive Officer for RAM Technologies which was sold in 1999.
